Dear Neighbour,

We are happy to inform you that the consultation for a PlayStreet afternoon in Boileau Road has been successful.

There was a positive response to the consultation, with 32 households taking part through either the online or paper survey and all were in favour of holding a PlayStreet. This means that the council has enough people in favour of the scheme to apply for a Traffic Order to close part of the street for a PlayStreet session.

The first PlayStreet event will be held on Sunday May 17th between 2pm and 4pm.

It's a great chance for people of all ages to get together and get to know each other a little better and build an even stronger community spirit and for the children to enjoy playing in their street in freedom and safety. So please come outside and join in the fun – and feel free to bring a cuppa. Bakers might like to bring a cake!

Practical matters:

During the PlayStreet session the upper part of the road – between Golf Road and Hanger Vale Lane - will be fully closed to through traffic, with stewarded access only for residents who need to use their car. Drivers who need to get to or from their homes in the road will be asked to travel at walking pace.

Ideally, we would appreciate it if people could move their cars out of the part of the road which will be closed. Several neighbours with homes on the Hanger Vale Lane side of the road are happy to let people park on land outside the back of their homes for the afternoon. There will be signs at the bottom (Queens Drive end) of the road and the top, warning drivers of the road closure. There will be full access to Thackery Court and the part of Hanger Vale Lane that runs behind Boileau Road.

We hope you will come and join in!
